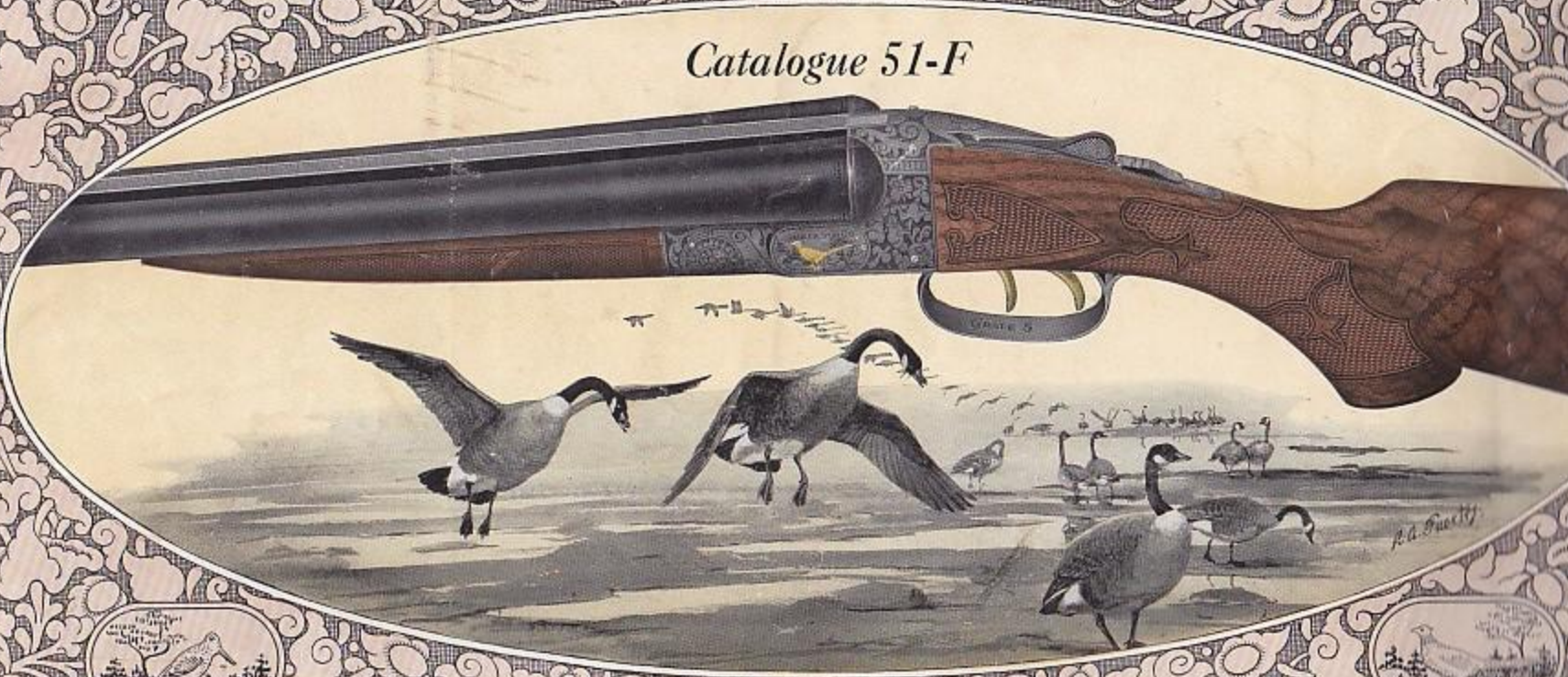

The New Ithaca Gun

Illustration will give you but a faint idea of the beautiful finish, workmanship and material of our Custom Built No. 7 Ejector One-Barrel Trap Gun.

—Especially selected walnut with handsome grain and color; hand fitted and finished in a very elaborate and artistic manner.

One-Barrel Trap Gun has the Ithaca lightning lock. A world's champion said of it, "It is like greased lightning." It has three lugs, two at the top and one at the bottom in form of fastening—bolted at two points. We guarantee Ithaca's not to shoot

the "beaver-tail" forearm, an Ithaca invention, fits the hand perfectly and keeps it cool in the hot barrel. The forearm is selected, finely figured wood, beautifully checkered and has an ebony tip in the end.

The receiver is ventilated to prevent heat wave annoyance. It is matted on top to prevent sun's rays, it gives a clean line of sight and it cannot shoot loose.

No picture can do justice to the beautiful engraving on this gun. Words are inadequate to describe it. The frame, guard, forearm iron, trigger plate, top lever and breech are elaborately engraved and ornamented with oak leaf and acorn design in relief, and designs on the right and left sides of the frame, ducks on one side and cats on the other. Three different colors of metal are used in inlaying the ducks and cats—red and yellow gold and silver, a gold elk's head is inlaid on the guard, an American eagle in gold and silver on the trigger plate. The trigger is triple gold plated and silver. It has a gold name plate in the stock.

This gun is made in a double gun as well as in a one-barrel trap gun as shown on

Forearm—Nicely figured black walnut carefully fitted, handsomely hand checkered, bed.

No. 4 Ejector is equipped with our lightning lock. The speed, simplicity, smooth working lock, snappy lock suits the trap-shooter because he can break more targets with it. This gun is double bolted and is double bolted. It will stand the continuous strain of shooting.

Frame, top lever, guard and trigger plate hand engraved in a beautiful, artistic manner. A trap-shooting scene on one side of the frame, an American eagle design on the other side, a hardened and polished trigger plate and name plate in the stock.

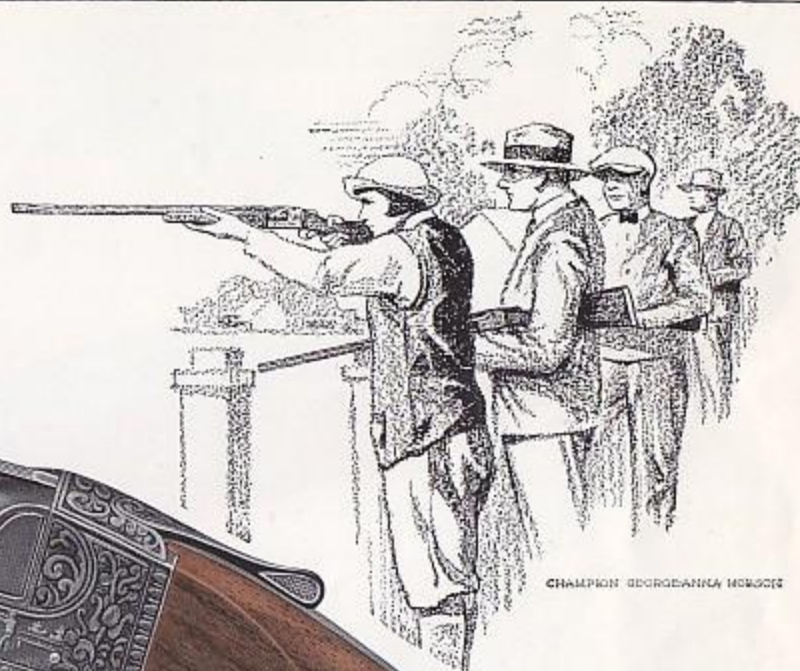

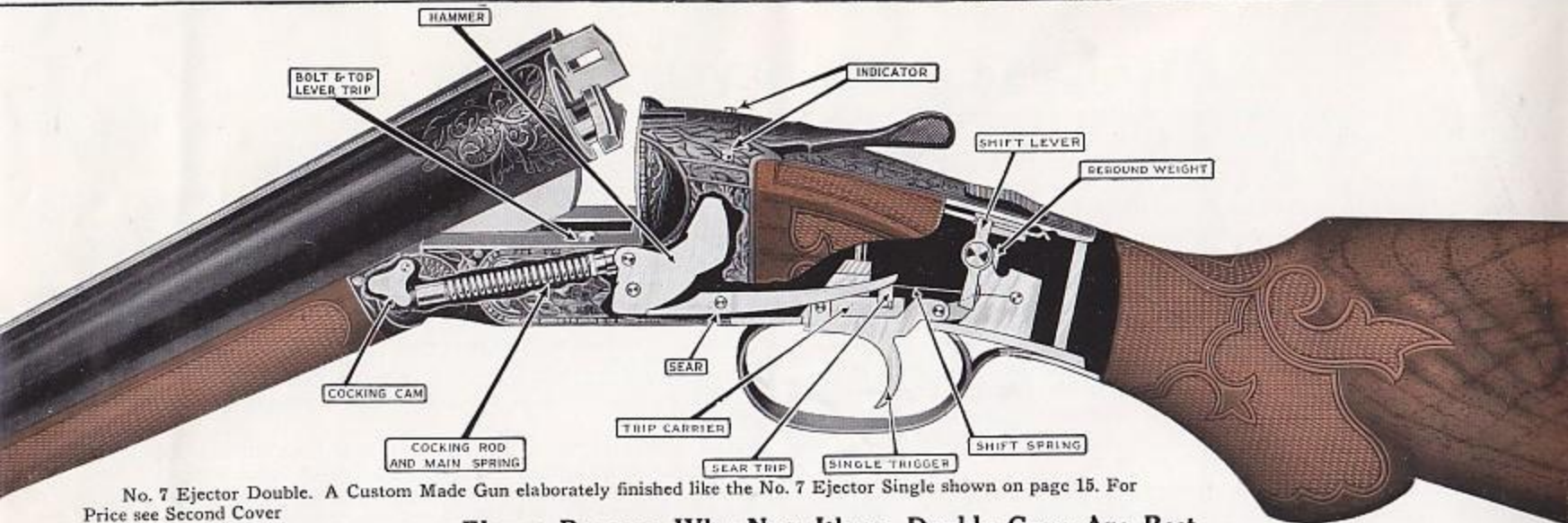

Eleven Reasons Why New Ithaca Double Guns Are Best

Reason 1—

The Ithaca double has three separate safety indicators:— First, the "S" seen in front of the safety button when the button is in safety position; second, a red spot back of the safety slide, indicating danger when the safety device is off; third, two indicator pins, which project out of and above the frame when the gun is cocked, each indicator disappearing when its barrel is fired.

Reason 2—Ithacas have lock speed.

The Ithaca lightning lock operates in $1/625$ of a second, it is by far the fastest lock ever invented. A bird flying a mile a minute would move only about one inch while an Ithaca lock was operating. This lock speed will improve anyone's shooting.

Reason 3—Ithacas have a quick, snappy pull.

The quick eye, active brain, responsive finger, quick, snappy trigger pull, fast lock and quick load form a chain of action—if one link is weak the chain is faulty. If you

are using a gun with a heavy or a slow, creepy trigger pull and a slow lock—two links in the chain are weak. There are no weak links in the Ithaca chain.

Reason 4—

The New Ithaca double is the smoothest and easiest working gun because it is the best designed gun.

Reason 5—Ithaca shooting qualities are warranted.

For nearly three generations Ithaca Guns have had the reputation of being the hardest shooting guns made. The Ithaca taper choke is the choke gunmakers try to copy. The Ithaca choke will never shoot out.

Reason 6—Ithaca stocks are let into the frame and solid where they join the frame. They are not cut away on the outside for lock plates, therefore are not so liable to check or split.

Reason 7—Ithaca coil springs do not break.

Did you ever think why coil springs are used under heavy freight cars? Why Uncle Sam uses coil springs in Army

guns? Because they do not break. Flat springs break. All new Ithaca Guns have coil springs. Ithaca wants them never to break.

Reason 8—Ithaca locks are simple, rugged and fast.

Reason 9—Ithaca rotary bolt fastenings do not slip. Metal working against metal will wear. If the mechanism of a gun is not made to take up the wear, it will shoot loose. Ithaca bolts are so fitted that they take up their own wear. That's why Ithacas cannot slip.

Reason 10—Ithaca frames and parts are drop forgings. Drop forgings are expensive, but they are tough, durable and safe.

Reason 11—Ithaca Guns are MADE IN AMERICA. If you want something done to an Ithaca in your own country, you know where the Ithaca factory is.

Custom Made No. 5 ejector Ithaca double is a thing of beauty. In the dainty little .410 or 28 gauge it is a delightful gun for "a lady" and in the big super or Magnum 10 bore it is THE water fowl "PAR EXCELLENCE."

Forearm—Superbly beautiful walnut with a gold name plate

fitted by an expert and polished like a mirror.

—An English Pheasant inlaid in pure gold or silver on the left side of the frame, the vanishing Woodcock in pure gold or silver on the right side, the American Eagle is engraved on the bottom of the frame, these are set in a background of leaf and flower design engraving, see second cover.

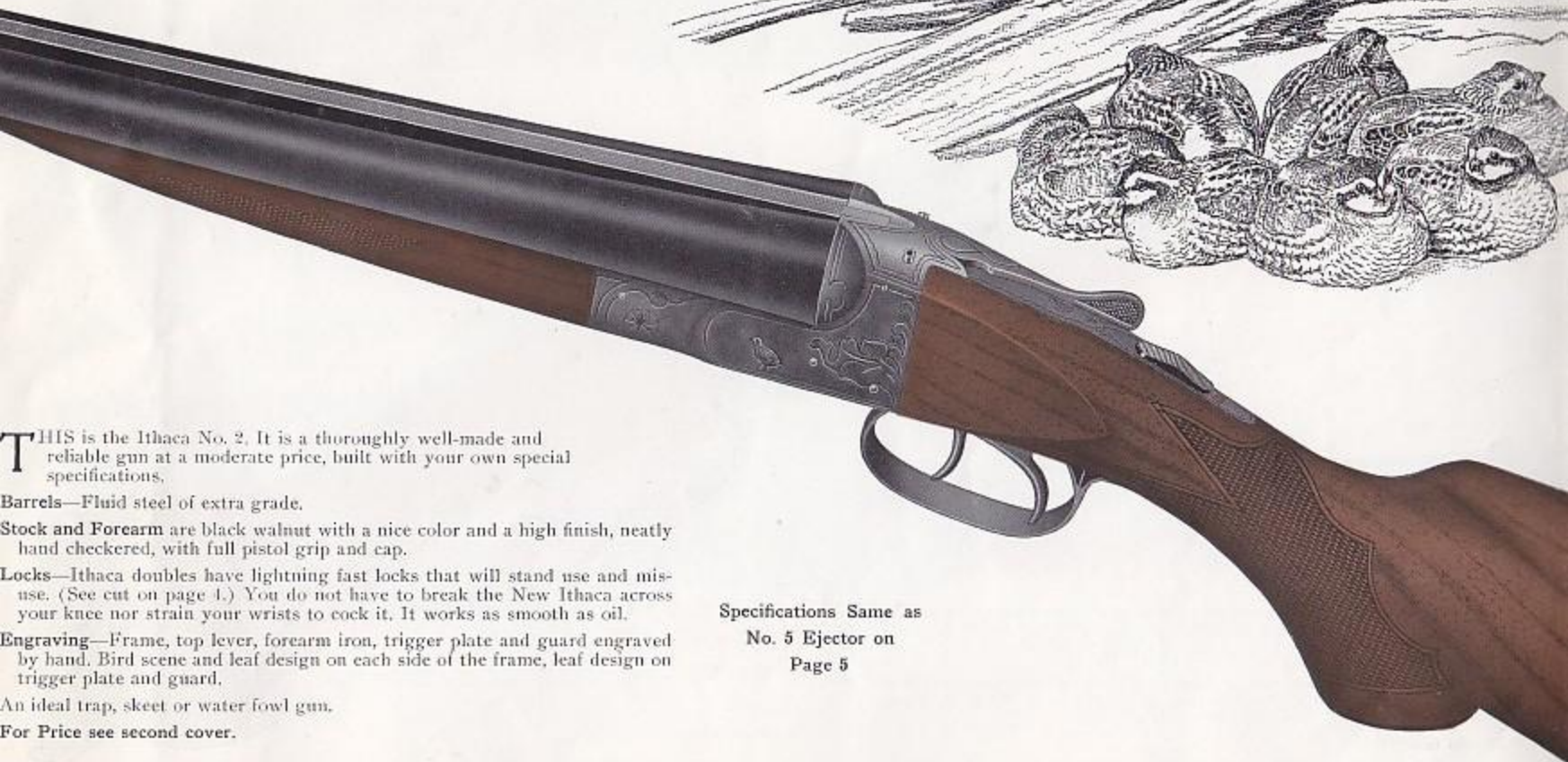


Here is the Ithaca No. 4 Ejector double with elevated Ventilated Rib, Selective Single Trigger and Beaver Tail Forearm, a combination pronounced by such gunners as Charles Young, Grand American Handicap winner, Frank Hughes, Amateur Champion, and O. N. Ford, Chairman Executive Committee Pacific International Trapping Association and former Vice President of the Amateur Trapshooters' Association, as the greatest double trap and water fowl gun yet produced. **When a shooter is up behind this gun he sees nothing but the top of the rib.** It is the most talked about Custom Made gun of today. This No. 4 Gun is also furnished with regular Forearm Rib, and with double triggers as shown on the No. 3 Gun on the opposite page.

THIS is the Ithaca No. 2. It is a thoroughly well-made and reliable gun at a moderate price, built with your own special specifications.

Barrels—Fluid steel of extra grade.

Stock and Forearm are black walnut with a nice color and a high finish, neatly hand checkered, with full pistol grip and cap.

Locks—Ithaca doubles have lightning fast locks that will stand use and misuse. (See cut on page 4.) You do not have to break the New Ithaca across your knee nor strain your wrists to cock it. It works as smooth as oil.

Engraving—Frame, top lever, forearm iron, trigger plate and guard engraved by hand. Bird scene and leaf design on each side of the frame, leaf design on trigger plate and guard.

An ideal trap, skeet or water fowl gun.
